

## Instructions to Undergraduate & Graduate Student Nominees to the BOARD OF GOVERNORS

- 1) Submit a completed copy of this form to the University Secretariat at <u>unielec@mcmaster.ca</u> by the close of the nomination period.
- 2) The **NOMINEE** may submit the one-page statement (approximately 300 words).
- 3) All approved candidates must attend a **mandatory campaign** information session to be held following the close of the nomination period. The dates and times will be sent to nominees at a later date.
- 4) The **Nominee** and all **nominators** must be members of McMaster University as defined below:

**UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT** means a full-time undergraduate student who has not been declared ineligible to continue at the University in the preceding Session; or a part-time student, a continuing student, or a second-degree student, registered for at least six units of undergraduate work.

**GRADUATE STUDENT** means a person who is proceeding toward a Master's or a Doctor's degree. Students registered in McMaster University degree programs in the McMaster Divinity College shall be eligible to be candidates for election as graduate students in the Faculty of Humanities. Any graduate student, either full-time or part-time, is eligible to be elected.

- 5) For undergraduate **nominees**, the (3) three **nominators** must all be **undergraduate** students; for graduate **nominees**, the (3) three **nominators** must all be **graduate** students.
- 6) Hard copy signatures are **not** required for nominators. In order to comply with nomination requirements all **nominators** must send an email **from** their McMaster email account **to the Nominee** with the following statement:

I nominate < NOMINEE NAME > as a candidate for election to the Board of Governors.

I understand that the University Secretariat may contact me to verify this nomination.
