



Instructions to Nominees

Please read these instructions carefully before completing your nomination form.

1) Submit a completed copy of this form to the University Secretariat at unielec@mcmaster.ca by the close of the nomination period. Be sure to fill out all fields on the form and your 300 word statement.

2) All approved candidates must attend a **mandatory campaign** information session to be held following the close of the nomination period. The dates and times will be sent to nominees at a later date.

3) The **Nominee and all nominators** must be members of McMaster University as defined below:

UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT means: a full-time undergraduate student who has not been declared ineligible to continue at the University in the preceding Session; or a part-time student, a continuing student, or a second-degree student, registered for at least six units of undergraduate work.

GRADUATE STUDENT means a person who is proceeding toward a Master's or a Doctor's degree. Students registered in McMaster University degree programs in the McMaster Divinity College shall be eligible to be candidates for election as graduate students in the Faculty of Humanities. Any graduate student, either full-time or part-time, is eligible to be elected.

4) **UNDERGRADUATE STUDENTS:** The (3) three **nominators** must all be undergraduate students registered in the same Faculty as the **Nominee**.

5) **GRADUATE STUDENTS:** The (3) three **nominators** must all be graduate students registered in the same Faculty as the **Nominee**. For graduate students in joint, collaborative, or interdisciplinary programs, the seconders must be registered in either the same program or in the same Faculty in which the candidate intends to run for election.

6) Hard copy signatures are **not** required for nominators. In order to comply with the nomination requirements, the following applies:

a) all **nominators** must send an email from their McMaster email account to the **Nominee** with the following statement:

I nominate <NOMINEE NAME> as a candidate for election to the Senate.

I understand that the University Secretariat may contact me via email to verify this nomination.
