Sustainable Building Policy

McMaster University will provide leadership in the conservation, protection, improvement and sustainability of the environment by:

- 1. Informing, supporting, and promoting sustainable building principles and benefits.
- 2. Implementing sustainable building principles in all new and existing buildings to achieve measurable life cycle cost savings.
- 3. Developing new and undertaking major renovations of occupied facilities to meet or exceed the Silver Level Rating of the LEED[™] (Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design) Rating System.
- 4. Developing new facilities to achieve a minimum annual energy consumption saving of 35% and developing renovated buildings to achieve savings of 25%, when compared with the Model National Energy Code for Buildings (MNECB).
- 5. Evaluating and changing, as appropriate, University processes to promote development and operation of sustainable buildings.
